



Tennis/Platform Tennis Court Rules

Court Usage Procedures

1. Tennis/Platform tennis court usage is on a first-come-first-on basis. Please register your guests at the Tennis/Platform Tennis Hut. There will be a \$5 per person guest fee. The court signup sheet is located at the Tennis/Platform Tennis Hut. Play is limited to one hour for singles and one and one half hour for doubles if others are waiting to play. When it is your turn to play wait until the point is completed and quietly walk on to the court. Players should relinquish the court in an expeditious and courteous manner.
2. Junior players under eighteen (18) years of age must defer court time to waiting adults if all courts are in use.
3. Use of the tennis and platform tennis courts is subject to control by the Club. The club shall determine the suitability of the courts for play. The courts will be closed when necessary for maintenance operations. The Tennis Professional has the authority to enforce the Club rules pertaining to the tennis courts.
4. The Tennis Professional is authorized to restrict play as may be necessary for the following events: league play, tennis lessons, camps or clinics, tennis events or tournaments, and tennis round robins or socials. Please check the Club newsletter for dates and times.
5. Platform Tennis court lights and heaters are controlled from the Tennis Hut. Please note that the heaters are used solely for the purposes of melting snow or ice from the courts.

General Court Rules

1. Players and spectators are requested to have consideration for others while playing or watching.

2. Smoking on the tennis & platform tennis courts is not permitted.
3. When retrieving a ball from another court, please wait until the point is over before asking for assistance or fetching the ball.
4. Only the actual players are allowed on the courts.
5. Please deposit all trash in the containers, which are located on each court.
6. Proper tennis attire is required at all times at the racquet facilities.
7. Players exhibiting loud or boisterous behavior or throwing and breaking their rackets may be asked to leave the tennis courts. Please report inappropriate behavior to the Tennis Professional or to the General Manager.
